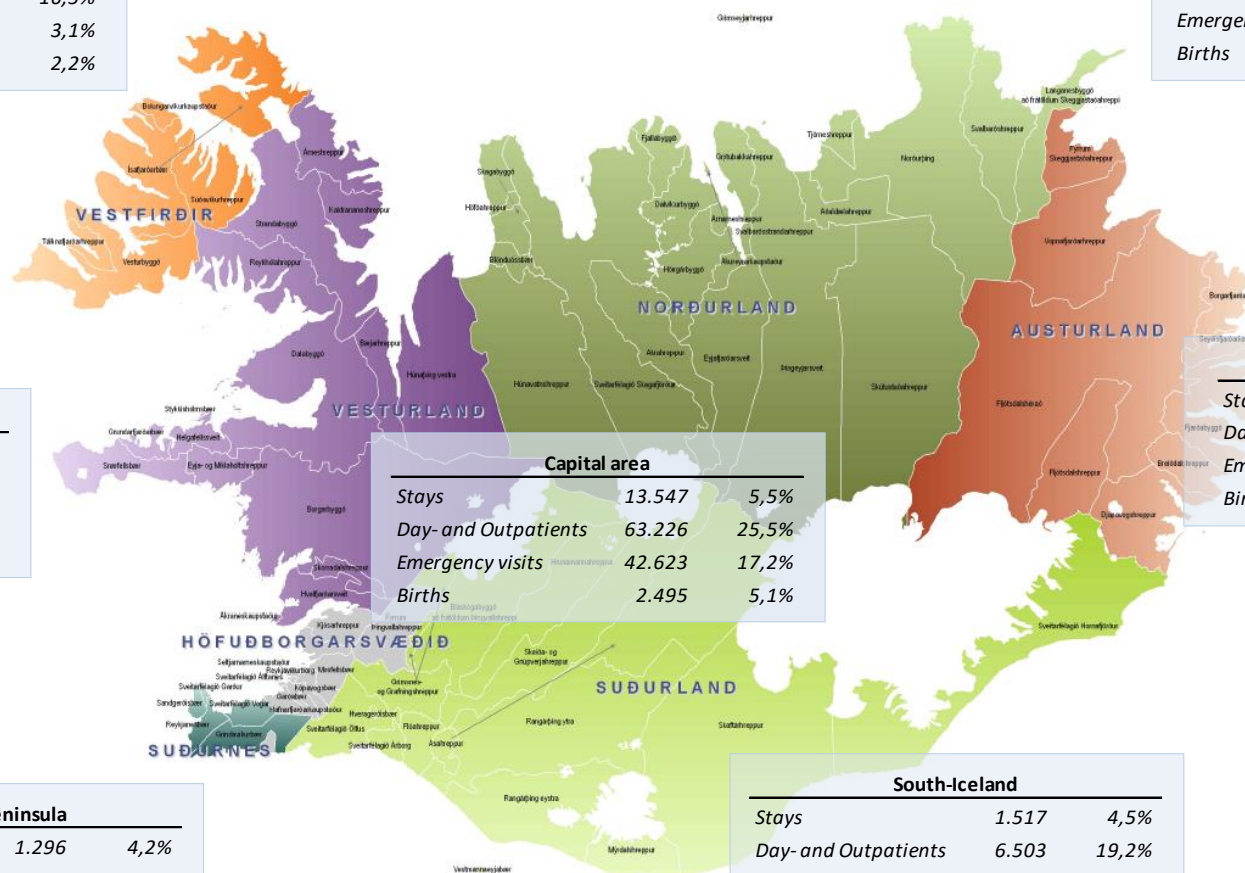

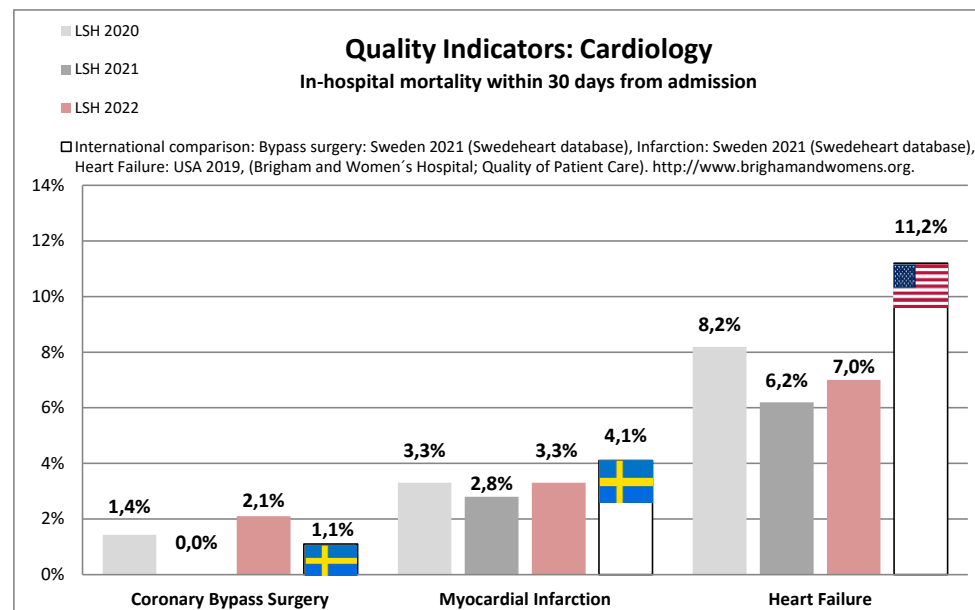
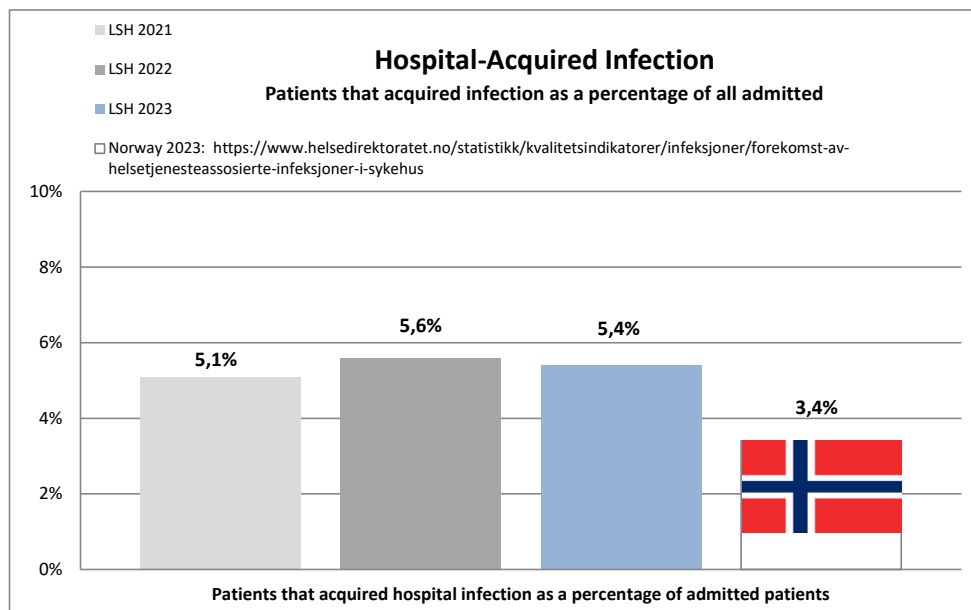
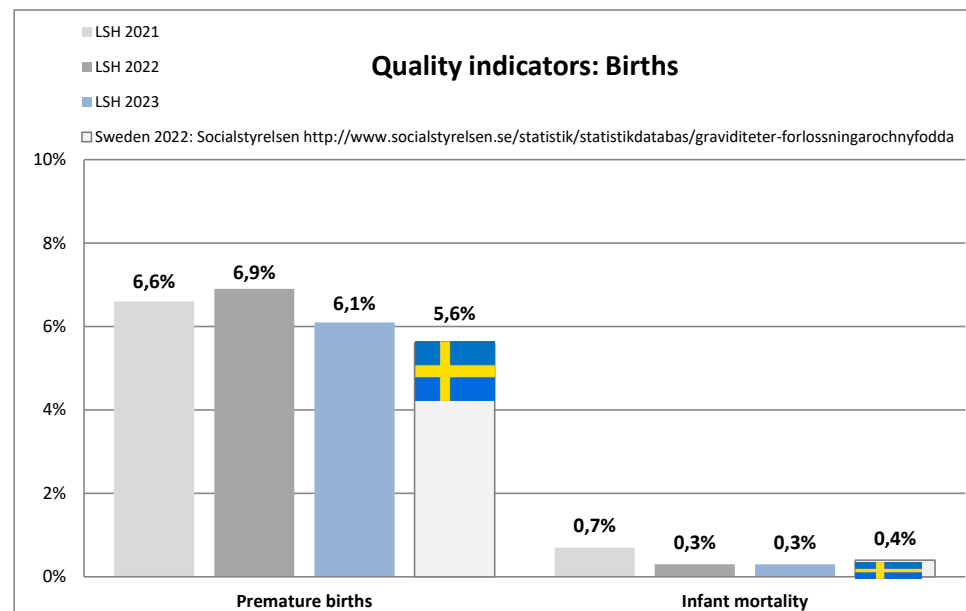
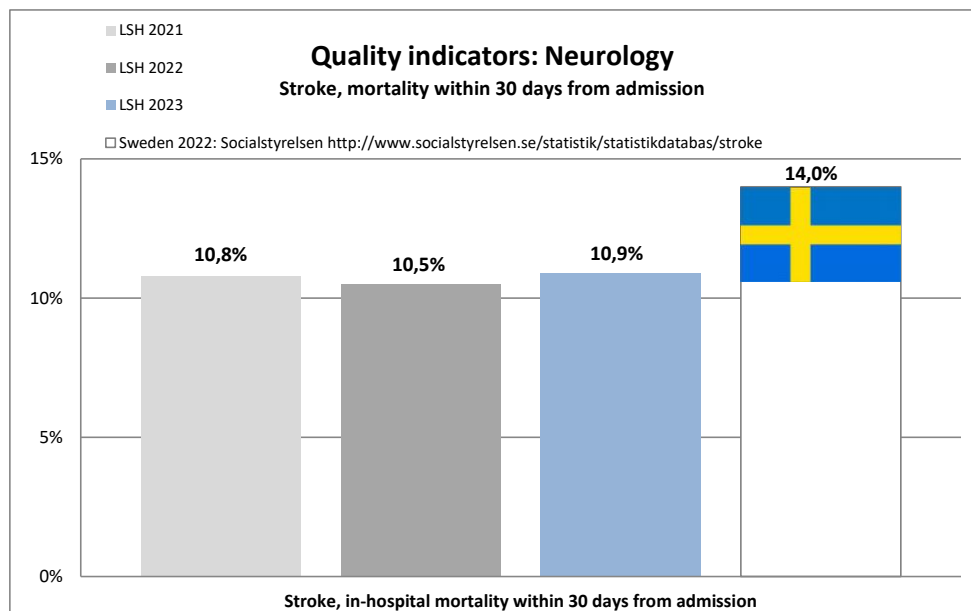


Inpatients; Main Diagnostic Categories (MDC) of the Diagnosis Related Groups (DRG) system

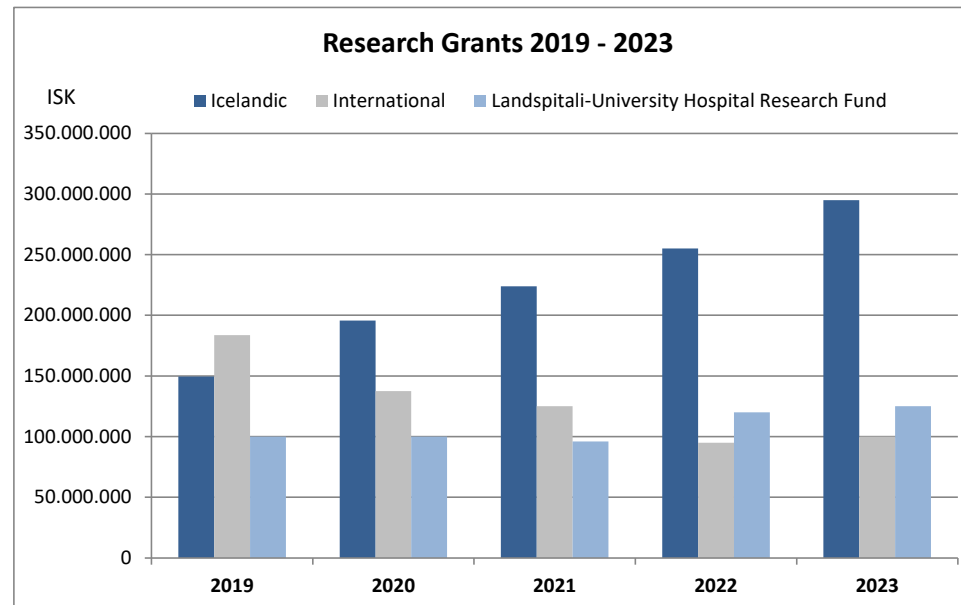
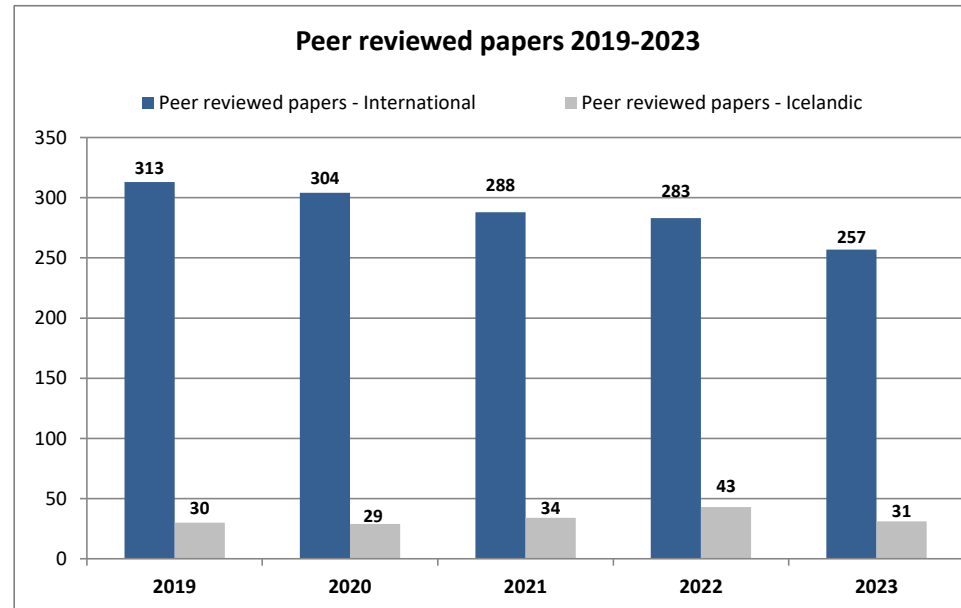
Number of inpatient stays 2021-2023

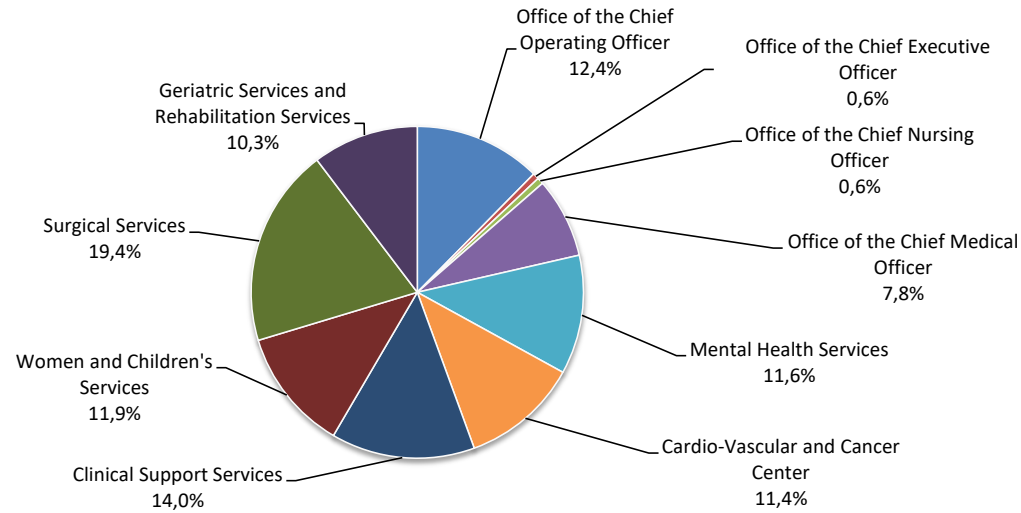

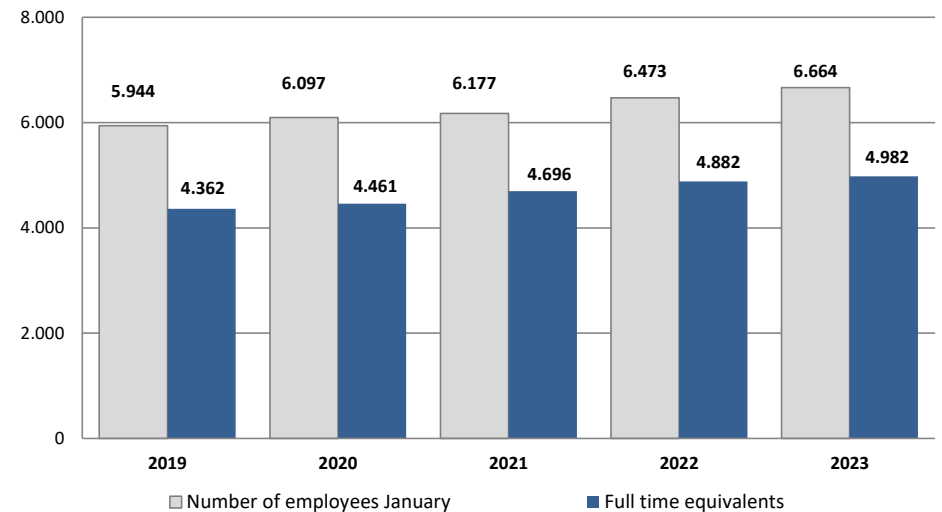
Fulltime equivalents (FTEs) divisional partition 2023

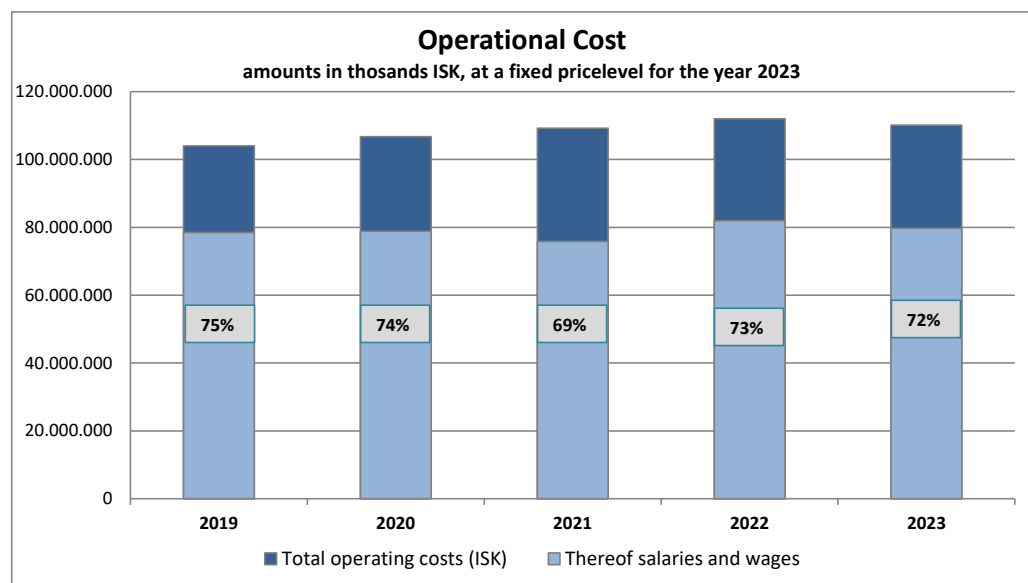

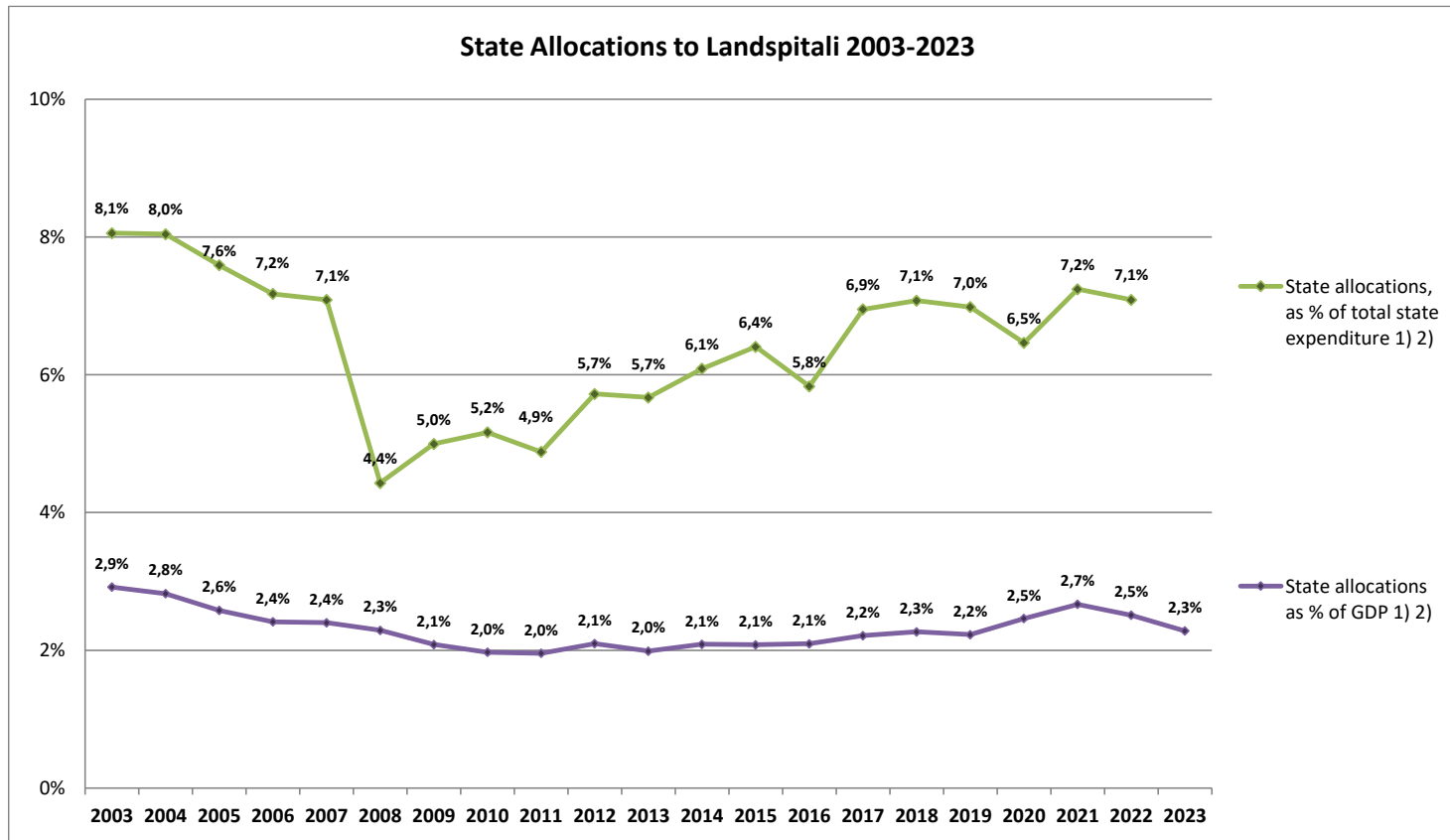
